

2021 BMLGC WEEKLY PLAY

Tee times and signup: Morning shotgun starts in May will be 9:00 a.m. June through August will start at 8:00 a.m. We will tee off at 9:00 a.m. during September. Evening shotgun will be 5:00 pm.

SIGN UP IN PRO SHOP OR CALL BEFORE NOON SUNDAY TO PLAY MONDAY

Fees: Weekly fees are \$5 for 9-hole players and \$9 for 18-hole players. The fee includes weekly play \$2, \$1 weekly point game, \$2 skins. Second nine for 18-hole player, \$2 low net and Skins \$2. Fees on scramble days \$2. For 9 holes.

Ways to Win:

1. Weekly games apply to first 9 only. Both the front nine and the back nine will be used. The schedule will be adjusted, as the pro shop deems necessary.
2. Weekly point game, May 3rd to September 20th. This is based on weekly net score for the first nine holes. Points that are earned will be explained on the bulletin board. No points on scramble days.
3. Match Play fees will be \$10 for 18-hole players and \$5 for 9-hole players. Match Play will begin in June. The pro shop will make brackets based on those who sign-up by June 15. Players will arrange the matches for times other than regular game days.
4. The Ladies Club Championship will be played on a Monday 10:00 am shotgun, September 20th.
5. Ringer Board (optional \$5 annual fee) The board will record the 1st scores of the season on the front or back after that the player will record any changes.
6. Skins will be paid to the single lowest net score and to the single lowest gross score on each hole.
7. Hole-in-one (\$1 not an option) when a member scores a hole-in-one on Ladies Day, she will immediately receive the whole amount in the Hole-in-One Account. All members will be required to pay \$1 each to reestablish the account.
8. Birdies and Chip-ins are recognized, so please note them on the scorecard... If you don't tell us, we don't know.

Reminders:

1. Check in 30 minutes before starting tee time for pairings to be made.
2. Count all strokes...even whiffs. Putt out all holes...no give-mes. Pick up when score totals 12.
3. Be considerate of others, put cell phones on vibrate.
4. Keep play moving along.
5. The pro shop will post our Ladies Day scores, but we are responsible for posting all of our other scores throughout the season! Accurate handicaps make the game more fun for everyone.
